She's lived in Arizona for over 35 years where she raised five beautiful children with her husband, Grant. While her husband served as Attorney General, Marlene was the primary breadwinner.

Outside of their respective careers, she and Grant were advocates for families and children here in Arizona. They were involved in various community programs, like the Boys and Girls Club and the Children's Museum.

In 2016, Marlene saw a shift in the country's direction and was appalled by the extremism that had emerged. She saw how poor leadership impacted our day-to-day lives, both nationally and right here at home and worked to elect common sense leaders in Arizona. She went on to chair now-Secretary of State Adrian Fontes's campaign and serve on Governor Hobbs' transition team.

Now, Marlene is running for Congress, to put country over party again. Marlene will be the type of leader we need in CD01. She's a great listener and recognizes that most Arizonans, like most Americans, are looking for a functioning government that focuses on finding solutions.
