About Susan Rubio

Born in Juarez, Mexico, Susan Rubio is the proud daughter of a bracero farmworker and housekeeper. She attended East Los Angeles College and earned bachelor's and master's degrees from Azusa Pacific University (CA-31). She also holds an honorary doctorate from the University of La Verne (CA-31). Susan Rubio was elected to the State Senate in 2018 and reelected in 2022. She previously served two terms on the Baldwin Park City Council and one term as City Clerk. Professionally, she served as a classroom teacher for 17 years in CA-31 in the cities of Baldwin Park and Monrovia, where she also served as assistant principal for three years. Rubio serves as Assistant Majority Whip of the State Senate, and she is the first Latina Chair of the Senate Insurance Committee, chairs the Select Committee on Domestic Violence, and serves on the following committees: Energy, Utilities, and Communications; Health; Transportation; Governmental Organization; and Joint Committee on Rules. She is also chair of the San Gabriel Valley Caucus and a member of the Latino Legislative Caucus, Legislative Jewish Caucus, Los Angeles Caucus, and Legislative Women's Caucus.
